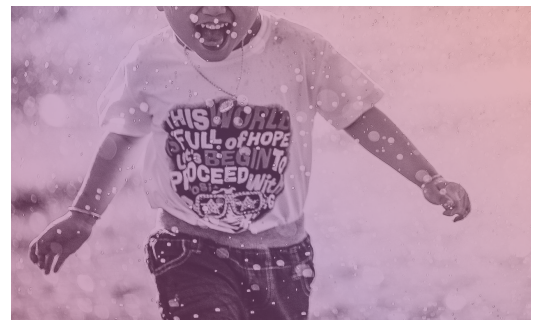

As a society, we trust first responders — those who are designated and trained to respond to emergency situations. At Love146, we are answering the call as first responders with trained, licensed social workers who provide rapid response and long-term care to children who’ve been hurt.

We are also committed to preventing this devastation from happening in the first place by reaching youth with education and skill building, providing the knowledge and the tools youth need to keep themselves safe.

This year we are excited to bring back Tread on Trafficking by hosting a 30-day wellness challenge in May. The campaign will include a virtual event on Thursday, May 27 featuring inspiring stories from Love146 Global Leadership as well as a celebration of those participating in Tread on Trafficking.
